- 5 firefighters are struck and killed each year
- 1 police officer is struck and killed each month
- 1 tow operator is struck and killed each week

*at or near traffic incidents.*

The Strategic Highway Research Program (SHRP 2) developed a program, by responders—for responders, with the objective that nationally, responders acquire a common set of core competencies for traffic incident management. The safety of responders and motorists, quick response, and effective communications at traffic incident scenes are highlighted.
