Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Johnson opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve our incident clearance times and to expand coordination between all TIM agency partners.
- The March 21st, 2017 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Overland Bridge Project Update by Bill Kays with KCCS

- The next planned traffic switch will be the northbound I-95 traffic switching to the new NB I-95 lanes from the northbound collector road sometime in July.
- All the beams are set for the new I-95 southbound bridge.
- Working on the northbound section of I-95 and the bridges over the NB I-95 entrance ramps from Philips Hwy as well as new I-95 pavement from San Diego to Atlantic.
- Crews have been working to set the last few beams for the bridge over the FEC Railroad and there is a need to shut down the access from downtown, (Main Street bridge, Acosta bridge, and the Ramp from Prudential at Main Street) to allow the crews to work on this bridge. All 3 ramps come together in the area under the bridge. This condition would continue through the work activities of setting the beams, placing the bridge deck, installing the traffic rails and painting.
- Upcoming work on westbound Atlantic in the South Shores, Old Hickory area in which the contractor is working to install the drainage structures. Afterwards, work will be done to bring up the grade and construct the new Atlantic roadway at a higher elevation to match Ramp K as it merges with Atlantic before Stevens Street.
- Fuller Warren, I-10 & I-95 Interchange Improvements:
 - A Public Information Handout was provided on the Upcoming Open House for the construction. The Open House is scheduled for Thursday, June 1st from 4:30 to 6:30pm at the FDOT Training Center.

- A handout was also provided to show the project layout and different colors for the new ramp construction, shared use path over the St Johns River adjacent to the Fuller Warren Bridge, and the sound walls on US 17/Roosevelt from McDuff to I-10.
- The contractor is working onsite to perform landscape relocation of the trees around the Pond areas, and to install erosion control as needed.
- The project is in the design phase and the contractor is working at the pier locations and along Riverside performing soil borings for design.
- The pond across Riverside from the Red Cross will be filled in and converted to parking.
- The contractor has selected their laydown yard location and it will be on Godwin Street off Edison Ave., adjacent to the FDOT parking lot area.
- It will still be several months before bridge work begins.

Construction Project Update by Ron Tittle

- The I-95 and JTB Project is moving along. Going into final phases with plans for completion in the summer, weather permitting.
- An upcoming project on I-95 from JTB to Atlantic Boulevard for express lanes is drawing public input now.
- The current Express Lanes project on I-295 from Buckman to I-95 should be open at the latter part of 2017. The I-295 West Beltway Express Lanes Project from JTB to I-95 is also moving along.
- The I-95 and I-295 North Interchange project is also moving along and the earthwork is being finished now.
- The I-10 and US 301 Interchange Project should be finished by spring 2019.

Emergency Operations Update by Ed Ward

- The Department is changing their evacuation plans from One-Way to Hard Shoulder Running. This emergency evacuation plan will be called Shoulder Use for Emergency Evacuation (SUEE). The plans are to implement this on I-10 WB on the West side of US 301 to I-75. The implementation on I-75 will go from near Tampa to the Georgia state line. I-10 will utilize the outside emergency lane while I-75 will utilize the inside lane.
- Statewide hurricane exercises will be performed beginning the first week of May.

ITS Update by Craig Carnes

- The I-95 project in St. Johns County is complete.
- The I-75 project installing ITS devices from SR-24 in Gainesville to the Georgia state line is ongoing. After this is finished, the entire I-75 corridor will have ITS coverage.
- The I-10 project installing Fiber Optic Cable (FOC) from US-90 in Tallahassee to Jacksonville is ongoing. The FOC being installed under this project will be utilized by another ITS project which will start in the fall and will install ITS devices on I-10 from US-90 to Jacksonville.
- The I-95 ITS Project in Nassau county will be awarded this summer and construction should start in the fall.
- Whenever these projects are finished, all Interstates within District Two will have ITS coverage. This means that all Design and Construction Projects will need to take the ITS infrastructure and devices into consideration.

511 and RTMC Update by Ryan Crist

- There were a lot of Twitter issues in May. IVR has been transferring people as it got more sensitive, and CCTVs were not refreshing images.
- A spike was noticed on the app and website over the 5 day TPC golf event.
- Arterial management is continuing to expand to get connectivity out to 3rd St and A1A.
- Upcoming connectivity to District 5 will help share streaming video to Flagler and Marion counties.

Road Ranger Update by Greg Gaylord

- The new Road Ranger fleet vehicles will be arriving in August.
- Construction zones are still an issue.

Performance Measures by Sherrell Lall

Sherrell provided the team with a Performance Measures presentation.

Incident Debrief - Ed's List by Team Members

The team members had an open discussion.

- I-95 Semi hanging over Beaver St. - Kudos were given to Walt's Wrecker in their ability to stabilize and get the semi out of the precarious spot it was in and minimize the clearance time.
- I-95 NB incident on the overpass of SR-16 – Greg provided a drone video of the incident scene.

SPARR by Dee Dee Johnson

- Dee Dee stated that FDOT may extend the app to construction or asset maintenance crews. This is still to be discussed.

Open Forum

- Annaleasa Winter with Florida Forestry gave a forestry report.
 - The rain helped clear up a lot of the fires near roadways.
 - The West Mims Fire in the Okefenokee Swamp will continue to burn for some time and only large amounts of rain will help put it out.
 - Burning yard debris is the leading wildfire cause.
 - Florida Burn Tools app provides information about active wild fires and other useful information. The app can be downloaded on the Apple App Store and on Google Play.
 - There are 104 active wildfires as of now.
- Greg Gaylord mentioned that 47 people received SHRP 2 Training during the tow show.
